**SUBJECT: In Support of Visa and Entry to the U.S.**

The purpose of this letter is to assist Texas A&M University international students with obtaining or renewing an F-1 or J-1 visa and/or entering the United States.

We request the following:

1. That all Texas A&M University F-1 and J-1 students be granted an emergency visa interview.
2. That all Texas A&M University F-1 and J-1 students be granted a visa, if otherwise eligible.
3. That all Texas A&M University F-1 and J-1 students be permitted entry to the United States to begin or continue their academic program or post-completion training, if otherwise eligible.

Texas A&M University students are expected to be on campus for Spring 2022. Classes begin January 18, 2022 for most academic programs. Some programs will have alternative start dates.
