SUBJECT: In Support of Visa and Entry to the U.S.

The purpose of this letter is to assist Texas A&M University international students with obtaining or renewing an F-1 or J-1 visa and/or entering the United States.

We request the following:

1. That all Texas A&M University F-1 and J-1 students be granted an emergency visa interview.
2. That all Texas A&M University F-1 and J-1 students be granted a visa, if otherwise eligible.
3. That all Texas A&M University F-1 and J-1 students be permitted entry to the United States to begin or continue their academic program or post-completion training, if otherwise eligible.

Texas A&M University students are expected to be on campus for the Summer and Fall 2022 semesters. Classes begin May 31, 2022 for the Summer 2022 semester and August 24, 2022 for the Fall 2022 semester for most academic programs. Some programs will have alternative start dates.
