Texas A&M University plans to hold in-person and hybrid classes for Spring 2021. The Spring 2021 semester will start January 19, 2021. Spring Break has been reduced to one day. The University will offer 50% of total course sections and 50% of undergraduate semester credit hours taught face-to-face. The goal is to provide undergraduate students with at least two face-to-face classes.

Please note that some Texas A&M University programs will have different start dates and are reflected on the I-20s and DS-2019s.

We will be adding remarks to student SEVIS records that reflect the Texas A&M University enrollment plan for Spring 2021. We will be updating the I-20s for students who will be travelling to the United States for Spring 2021.
